Arisaema murrayi (Grah.)Hook.var. Sonubeniae P.Tetali, Punekar & Lakshmin.

Botanical name: Arisaema murrayi (J. Graham) Hook. var. sonubeniae P.Tetali, Punekar & Lakshmin.

Vernacular name: Patari

Family : Araceae

Threatened category: Not assessed.

- **Key characters:** Tuberous terrestrial monoecious / dioecious herbs, Spathe tube purple-lavender in upper half with a scarlet blotch at the base on the anterior side, Spathe limb pale purple-lavender with a dark purple blotch at the base, stigma capitate.
- **Description:** Perennial herbs. Corms warty, Leaves mostly solilarv, petiole 12—10 cm long, light green in mature plants, greyish-brown tinged when young; leaf blade subpedatisect, leaflets 5 9, sessile, 5.5 17 x 1.7 6.5 cm, elliptic to obovate, base cuneate apex caudate in monoecious plants, mucronate in dioecious male plants, dark or pale green above, glossy below; midrib, veins and veinlets prominently raised below, lateral nerves 10- 12, spathe tube purple-lavender in the- upper half with a scarlet blotch at the base on the anterior side, the spathe limb curved downwards, pale purple-lavender with a dark purple blotch at the base, stigma capitate and the appendix dark purple in the lower half and white- in the- upper half. In the typical variety, the tube is green with paler longitudinal stripes, becoming white near the mouth. The limb is almost at right angles to tin-lube and while with translucent veins and a cherry-red cross band at the base (except at the rear), and the appendix is green suffused with purple.


Flowering and fruiting: June – Oct.

Distribution: Endemic to Maharashtra- Pune and Nasik district.

- **Reported Localities**: Pune (Ganesh Khind in Junnar taluka , Junnar-khangaon road, Bhimashankar,) Nasik (Peint Taluka, Trimbak, near Lagnastambha temple.)
- **Ecology**: Teak forest on hill slopes and in crevices and near boulders. Altitude ranges between 600-1200m above sea level.
- **Association**: No specific plant association is observed. However, grows among bushes like Ampelocissus latifolius, Artemisia sp Curcuma pseudomontana, Dioscorea oppositifolia, Gloriosa superba, Habenaria foliosa var. foetida, etc.




1.Habit,2. Spathe, 3. Spadix, 4.,6.,7.& 9. Gynoecium, 5. & 8. Anthers.






