Habenaria brachyphylla (Lindl.) Aitch.

Botanical name: Habenaria brachyphylla (Lindl.)Aitch. (=H. crassifolia A. Rich.,= Platanthera brachyphylla Lindl.)

Vernacular name: -

Family : Orchidaceae

Threatened category: Low risk (Gaikwad & Yadav, 2004).

Key characters: Herbs, Petals entire, Petals ovate or ovate-oblong; segments of lip linear-oblong, sub equal., Tubes of anthers cells short.

Description: Terrestrial herbs, 16-18 cm long. Tubers 1-2, 1.5 - 2.5 cm, ovateelliptic or broadly ovate. Leaves fleshy, 2 or 3, variable; lower 2 leaves similar, the uppermost different, often all 3 quite similar; lower leaves 2.5-13.0 X 2-10 cm, broadly ovate, oblong-ovate, oblong-elliptic or sub orbicular, acute or acuminate. Flowers white in elongated many flowered lax racemes, 15-55 cm long, about 0.7 X 0.9 cm, bracteate, shortly pedicellate. Petals with a strong mid rib and with two weak nerves. Lip 3 lobed, lateral lobes shorter. Rostellum erect. Capsules 1.5 X 0.4 cm, ellipsoid, ribbed, beaked.

Flowering and fruiting: August- October


Distribution: India – Endemic to India.

Localities: Ahmednagar, Kolhapur, Nasik, Pune, Ratnagiri, and Satara.

Ecology: Occasionally seen growing near bushes of grass lands at high altitudes, ranging between 900-1200m above sea level.

Association: No specific plant association is observed.
