Family: Lentibulariaceae

Threatened category: Low risk (Gaikwad & Yadav, 2004)

Key characters: Terrestrial herb, Racemes erect, bracts basifixed, flowers purple, spur shorter than lower lip straight, upper lip of the corolla obovate, seeds ellipsoid, hilum subterminal, testa cells linear.

Description: Erect herbs, 8-16 cm high. Glandular. Branches few, arranged alternately, rhizoids bear a few bladders. Leaves 0.2 – 0.4 cm long. Spathulate, bearing bladders, deciduous. Scapes erect, 1-3 (rarely 4-5) flowered. Flowers bluish-purple, pedicels flat, spur curved. Upper lip white, notched at apex, 4.5-6-3-4.5mm. Lower lip often rectangular when spread. Spur, conical, slightly curved, 6-9mm long, Capsules bag shaped enclosed in persistent calyx, compressed, 4.5X3mm long.

Flowering and fruiting: July -November.

Distribution: India – Endemic to Western Ghats.

Reported Localities: Kolhapur, Satara, Sindhudurg.

Ecology: Grows gregariously on open, moist, gravelly laterite soils along the ghats between 900-1200m above sea level.

Association: No specific plant association is observed, but shares similar habitats preferred by *Eriocaulon* sp.






